5 DAY MEMBER

Terms & Conditions

1. A 5 day member is entitled to play the course as follows –

Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday

Thursday (Ladies day) - between 2.00pm and 3.30pm

Friday up to 3.00pm and after 5.00pm

Sunday after 1 pm.

The Council may at times give priority to bookings from visitors, societies etc. It is advisable for **all** members to check with the Club Professional (01925 762013) before playing to avoid disappointment. The times when the course is booked can be found on the course notice board for member's convenience.

2. A 5 day member may introduce three visitors on any weekday at the reduced rate and one visitor on Sunday. Any one visitor may only be introduced to the Club, at the reduced rate, a maximum of 6 times in any one calendar year.
3. A 5 day member may apply for a handicap certificate on completing three medal rounds signed by a full member.
4. A 5 day member, with a club handicap, is entitled to play in competitions on Wednesdays and Sundays, with the exception of Club Board competitions and is eligible to win a prize as determined by the Competitions committee for that competition. Please check eligibility with the Club Professional prior to taking a start time.
5. A 5 day member is entitled to use the Practice Areas free of charge Monday to Sunday.
6. A 5 day member is entitled to use the Clubhouse and all its facilities Monday to Sunday.
7. Entrance Fees and Subscriptions will be agreed annually at the AGM. Payment methods will be the same for all categories of membership.
8. Should Full membership become available this will be offered to 5 day members as a priority before being made available to the waiting list.
9. A 5 day member may not attend club meetings, vote at the AGM or take part in the management of the Club.

10. The Council reserves the right to vary its terms and conditions as it deems necessary from time to time.

11. Any person who agrees to join the Club and pays the subscription has accepted all these terms and conditions.

A Club diary will be provided to each member (subject to availability) and it is suggested by the Council that each member should make themselves aware of its contents. The diary includes details such as priorities arranged for the year, any restrictions governing play, etiquette of golf and the Club dress rules. The rules and regulations are designed for the benefit of **ALL** member's, failure to comply may lead to argument and frustration. Should the need arise a copy of the disciplinary procedure is available on request.

The council wish that members enjoy their golf and meet a wide circle of new friends through the social calendar event.
